

# Saar boom town

## ● Hotel and villa complex on way

A NEW commercial and residential complex may soon be built in Saar, it has been announced.

City Complex will be built on 112,717sqm and will include a mall, a 10-storey hotel and a villas compound.

Work on the project, which will be carried out by Emaar, has been given initial approval by the Northern Municipal Council.

The council is yet to receive the cost of the multimillion dinar project.

Council chairman and area councillor Yousif Al Boori said it would be built near the US ambassador's residence and neighbours have already welcomed it.

"I have no problem with the project, although we are missing a number of details, which we hope would be given to us soon," he said.

"The council's technical committee has been assigned to study it with the investors to prepare a comprehensive report to help us take the final decision.

"We will support as many projects as possible to ensure that we attract more investments to the area to ensure further development of its infrastructure."

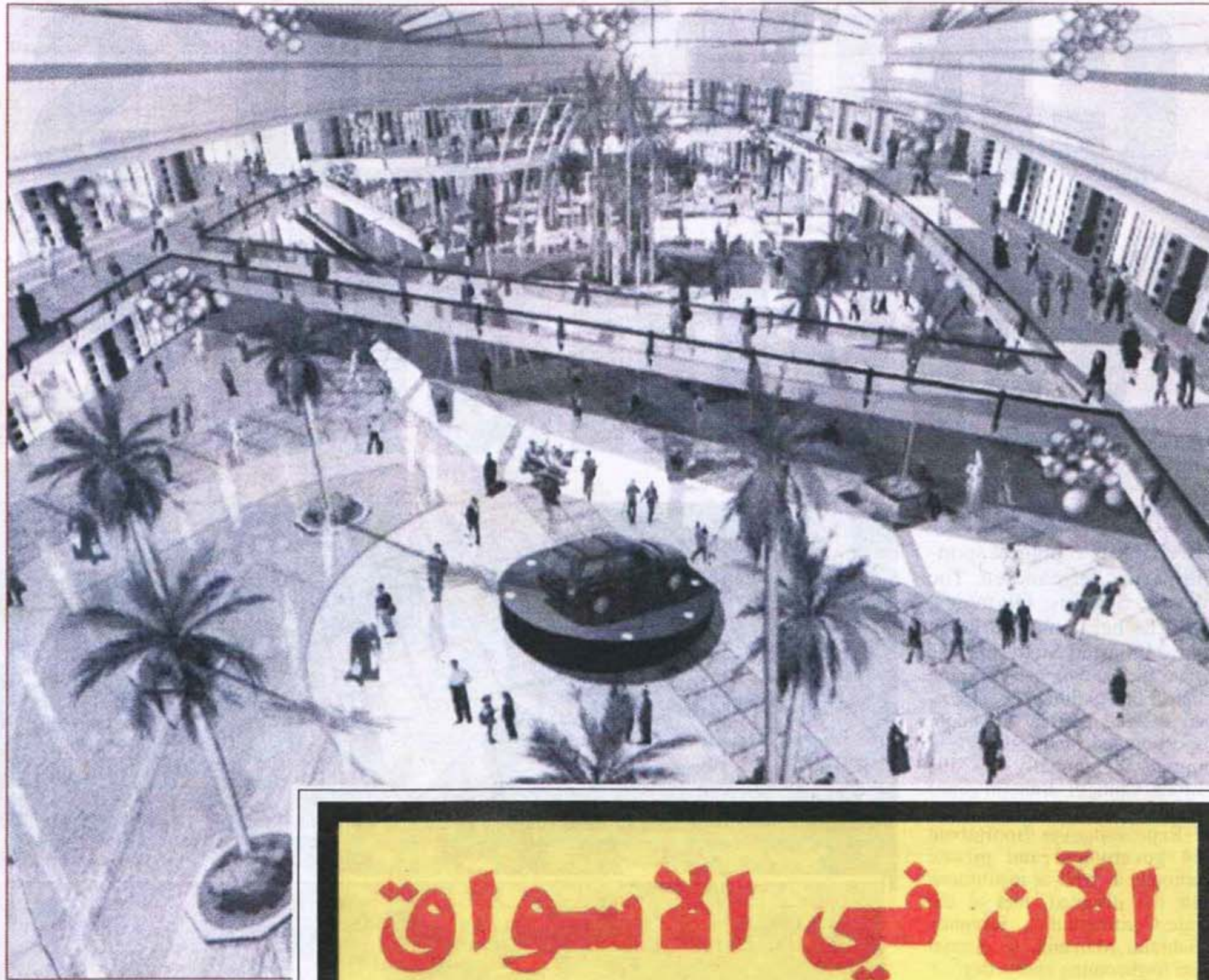
Mr Al Boori said the project would be divided into two sections.
